Environmental Policy objectives

Peter Stevens Estates environmental policy has three primary areas:

1. Management and control

The company will provide adequate resources to ensure that all employees at all levels of the business have sufficient training and supervision to successfully implement the environmental policy.

Peter Stevens Estates will assess the environmental impacts of its investment decisions particularly in respect of capital expenditure projects and will use appropriate environmental standards to evaluate materials and goods purchased.

2. Waste minimisation and recycling

The company will reduce its operational waste by recycling and reusing materials wherever possible. Disposal of any residual waste will be managed in a way that is consistent with the ultimate aim to send zero waste to landfill.

To assist with the goal of waste minimisation the company will:

- Recycle all materials created through the refurbishment process
- Ensure that all contractors follow the same recycling process
- Designate recycling points for each refurbishment site
- Assess the performance of each project

3. Environmental legislation

All procedures and activities undertaken will comply with environmental legislation.

The Directors of the company oversee the implementation and continuous improvement of the environmental policy and aim to go beyond legislative requirements.
